Rachel E. Behrman is the Associate Commissioner for Clinical Programs and Director of the Office of Critical Path Programs, U.S. Food and Drug Administration. In that capacity, she is responsible for developing, coordinating, and implementing policy and scientific programs aimed at innovating development and regulation of FDA-regulated products. Dr. Behrman joined the FDA in 1989 and has held a number of positions in the Center for Drug Evaluation and Research, including medical reviewer and team leader in the Division of Antiviral Drug Products and deputy director of the Office of Medical Policy.
